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Pompomlicious

Skill level: Easy

Gauge: in double crochet 24 st. by 10 rows = 4 inches (10 cm)

After blocking.

Stitches used and abbreviations:

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

Dc2tog = double crochet 2 together

Fpdc = Front post double crochet

Bpdc = Back post double crochet

Sl st = slip stitch

Rep = repeat

St = Stitch(es)

Dec = decrease

Yarn: Knit Picks Hawthorne Fingering (80% superwash Fine Highland Wool, 20% Polyamide) Sample in colorway "Vancouver"

Yardage: Toddler 400 yards, Child: 500 yards Adult 600 yards

(366, 457, 548 meters)

Hook: Crochet hook C (2.5 mm) or necessary hook to obtain

gauge.

Other Materials: Yarn needle (to sew edges and weave in

ends)

Sizes: Toddler, Child, and Adult

-Hat: To fit circumference: 18/19 in; 19/20 in; 21/22 in

(45/48cm; 48/50cm; 53/55 cm)

-Scarf: 4.5 by 38 in; 4.5 by 48 in; 4.5 by 60 in (12 by 97 cm; 12

by 122 cm; 12 by 152 cm)

Final measurement of the scarf can vary depending if the blocking is done lightly or aggressively.











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HAT:

In a magic ring:

Round 1: Ch3. 11 dc. SI st to close. (Ch3 counts as 1st dc - 12 st)

Round 2: Ch4. *dc in next st, ch1, - Rep from * until end of round. SI st to close. (24 st)

Round 3: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next st. *2 dc in next st. 1 dc in next st. - Rep from * to end of round. SI st to close. (36 st)

Round 4: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next 2 st. * 2dc in next st. Dc in next 2 st. Rep from * to end of round. SI st to close. (48 st)

Round 5: Ch4, Dc in next 3 st. *dc in next st. ch1. Dc in next 3 st. Rep from * to end of round. Sl st to close. (60 st)

Round 6: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next 4 st. *2dc in next st. dc in next 4 st. - Rep from * to end of round. SI st to close. (72 st)

Round 7: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next 5 st. *2dc in next st. dc in next 5 st. - Rep from * to end of round. SI st to close. (84 st)

Round 8: Ch3. Dc in same st. [ch1. Skip 1 st. Dc in next st.] x3. * 2dc in next st. [ch1. Skip 1 st. dc in next st] x3 - Rep from * until end of round. SI st to close. (96 St.)

Toddler size only: Skip to round 15

Round 9: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next 7 st. *2dc in next st. dc in next 7 st. - Rep from * to end of round. Sl st to close. (108 st)

Child size only: Skip to round 15

Round 10: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc in next 8 st. *2dc in next st. dc in next 8 st. - Rep from * to end of round. Sl st to close. (120 st)





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Round 11: Ch3. Dc until end of round. SI st to close.

Round 12: Ch3. Dc in next st. Ch1. Skip 1 st. *dc in next 2 st. Ch1. Skip 1

stitch. - Rep from * to end of round. SI st to close.

Rounds 13 to 14: Ch3. Dc until end of round. SI st to close.

Rounds 15 to 20: Repeat rounds 12 to 14 consecutively.

Rounds 21 and 22: Ch1. Sc until end of round. SI st to close.

Round 23: Ch3. Dc until end of round. SI st to close.

Rounds 24 to 26: Ch3. * Fpdc. Bpdc - Rep from * to end of round. SI St

to close.

Fasten off yarn. Weave in ends and block to measurements.

Make pompom and add it to the top of the hat.

SCARF:

Row 1: Ch4. 3 Dc in 4th ch from hook. (4 st.)

Row 2: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc to last st. 2dc in last st. (6 st.)

Row 3: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc to last st. 2dc in last st. (8 st.)

Row 4: Ch3. Dc in same st. Ch2. Skip 2 st. Dc in next 2 st. Ch2. Skip 2 st.

2dc in last st. (10 st.)

Row 5 to 7: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc to last st. 2dc in last st. (12, 14, 16 st)

Row 8: Ch3. Dc in same st. [ch2. Skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st.] x 3. Ch2. skip

2 st. 2dc in last st. (18 st)

Rows 9 to 11: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc to last st. 2dc in last st. (20, 22, 24 st)

Row 12:Ch3. Dc in same st. [ch2. Skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st.] x 5. Ch2. skip 2 st. 2dc in last st. (26 st)

Rows 13 to 14: Ch3. Dc in same st. Dc to last st. 2dc in last st. (28, 30 st)





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Row 15: Ch3. Dc across.

Row 16: Ch3. Dc in next st. *ch2. Skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st. - Rep from *

until end of row.

Row 17 to 19: Ch3. Dc across.

Row 20: Ch3. Dc in next st. *ch2. Skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st. - Rep from *

until end of row.

Row 21 to 80: Repeat rows 17 to 20 consecutively.

Toddler size only: Skip to row 137

Row 81 to 100: Repeat rows 17 to 20 consecutively.

Child size only: Skip to row 137

Row 101 to 136: Repeat rows 17 to 20 consecutively.

Row 137: Ch3. Dc across.

<u>NOTE</u>: Because a dc2tog is hard to do at the beginning of a row, instead of ch3 as usual, here we use a ch2 to create a decrease.

Row 138 and 139: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) Dc to last 2 st. Dc2tog. (28, 26 st)

Row 140: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) [ch2, skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st.] x 5 Ch2. skip 2 st. Dc2tog. (24 st)

Row 141 to 143: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) Dc to last 2 st. Dc2tog. (22, 20, 18 st)

Row 144: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) [ch2, skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st.] x 3 Ch2. skip 2 st. Dc2tog. (16 st)

Row 145 to 147: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) Dc to last 2 st. Dc2tog. (14, 12, 10 st)





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Row 148: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) ch2, skip 2 st. dc in next 2 st. Ch2.

skip 2 st. Dc2tog. (8 st)

Row 149 to 151: Ch2. Dc in next st. (dec) Dc to last 2 st. Dc2tog. (6, 4, 2

st)

Fasten off. Block to straighten up the edges. Make 2 pompoms and add one to each end of the scarf.
